
⚠ This mixer is recommended for equal high (mains) pressure water supply only.

To ensure the optimum performance and customer satisfaction please adhere to the following:

- · Flush out all pipe work prior to installation.
- Minimum flow pressure for satisfactory operation: (Hot and Cold) 150kPa
- Maximum static water pressure: 1500kPa. If the water pressure exceeds or is likely to exceed 1500kPa, an approved pressure limiting valve must be fitted.
- · Maximum hot water temperature: 60°C. If the water temperature exceeds 60°C, an approved tempering valve must be fitted.
- Installation should comply with relevant local authority requirements.
- In accordance with good plumbing practice, filters should be fitted to supply lines to eliminate damage to the ceramic cartridge from suspended solids.
- AS/NZS 3500.1 states that pressures above 500kPa can cause damage from water hammer, reduce the life of appliances, taps & fittings, cause excessive noise in the system and recommend that a pressure limiting valve (PLV) be fitted.






BEFORE INSTALLATION






1. Remove screws, small mounting plate, protective shell and spirit level.




2A. Screw inlet pipes into mixer body and push fit inlet pipes into base mount. Ensure hot and cold pipes are located in the hot and cold inlets.


2B. Position bath filler in place and ensure that the mixer handle is accessible in the desired mounting location. Ensure that the mixer inlets are at 90° to handle and cartridge when mixer is in the final position.




2C. Remove inlet pipes from base mount, screw on outer sleeve, fit base cover plate and screw on small mounting plate.



3. Using the protective shell as a template to mark the mixer (See Diagram A). With a hacksaw, cut the floor mounting points of the mixer as marked. This is so the mixer will fit in the ø100mm hole later in the installation.




4. Fix the bath filler assembly, large mounting plate and mixer together with the supplied screws. Ensure that the supply pipes are aligned and fitted into the mixer before tightening the screws and that the hot and cold match up with the mixer handles.




5. Before cutting the hole, ensure that there is sufficient depth below the wood floor for the mixer (See Diagram A). With a hole saw, cut a ø100mm hole in the wood floor. The hole should not exceed 100mm diameter or there will be insufficient surface area for


mounting the large mounting plate (ø140mm) of the mixer.




6. Using the supplied spirit level, ensure base mount and mixer are level. If the mixer is twisted or uneven the o-ring seal in the base mounts may dislodge and leak.



7. Using the 8 supplied wood screws, fix the bath filler into the wood floor.




8. Connect the hot and cold water source to the mixer location. Make sure to purge the pipe before connecting to the mixer. Test watertightness.




9. Upon completion of floor finish, push the base plate until flush with floor and covering mixer hole. Silicone is optional under the inner edge of the plate.







1. Remove screws, small mounting plate, protective shell and spirit level.




- 2A. Insert inlet pipes into mixer body and fit into base mount with green protective shell fitted. Ensure hot and cold pipes are located in the hot and cold inlets.
- 2B. Position bath filler in place and ensure that the mixer handle is accessible in the desired mounting location. Mark mixer handle location on green protective shell.
- 2C. Remove inlet pipes from base mount, screw on outer sleeve, fit base cover plate and screw on small mounting plate.




3. Fix the bath filler assembly, protective shell and mixer together with the supplied screws. Ensure that the supply pipes are aligned and fitted into the mixer before tightening the screws. If the mixer is twisted or uneven the o-ring seal may dislodge and leak.




4. Cut a $\varnothing 150$ mm hole by 70mm deep into the concrete. Make sure the cut hole provides sufficient space to connect water sources and a level surface for the mixer to be fixed upon. The hole should not exceed $\varnothing 150$ mm or there will be insufficient surface area for mounting.







5. Referring to mixer handle location, position bath filler and mark out the four floor mounting points, ensuring that the mixer inlets are at 90° to handle and cartridge when mixer is in the final position.




7A. Drill four ø8mm x 45mm deep holes in the marked locations. 7B. Remove the nut and washers from the supplied Dynabolt and fit Dynabolt into each drilled hole.



8. Fit the mixer back into position and secure into place with the washer and nut of the Dynabolts.



Connect the hot and cold water source to the mixer location.
 Make sure to purge the pipe before connecting to the mixer.
 Test water tightness.



10. Upon completion of floor finish, push the base plate until flush with floor and covering mixer hole. Silicone is optional under the inner edge of the plate.

Warranty, Maintenance and Care - YOUR COPY TO KEEP

Felton Industries Limited guarantees these mixers to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of ten (10) years from the date of purchase. Fair wear and tear is expressly excluded. This warranty is effective for 10 years from the date of purchase for the supply of replacement parts (only) and 5 years from the date of purchase for plumber's labour relating solely to repairing or replacing the mixer, provided the product is installed by a registered plumber. You must retain proof of purchase of the Mixer (such as an invoice or receipt) and proof of installation by a registered plumber and provide these to Felton on request. This warranty is for manufacturing defects only and does not cover any damage to the product due to abuse, negligence or improper installation. This warranty is given on the understanding that the product is installed by a registered plumber and operated according to Felton's installation guide and the Australian/New Zealand standard AS/NZS3500. This warranty is provided to persons who are a "consumer" under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 only and for use in domestic/residential dwellings only (not for commercial use).



At no stage should any surface coatings be cleaned with cleaning agents that contain a corrosive acid or a scouring additive. Surface coatings should be cleaned with liquid detergent or soap and water. Any damage caused through the use of an unsuitable cleaner will not be covered by this warranty. This warranty is subject to any other rights or remedies that you may have under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 (or any other applicable legislation) and to Felton's Terms of Trade.

In order to obtain a Lifetime Extension Warranty to the standard warranty, please read and follow the terms and conditions of your warranty (on reverse). This warranty is subject to, and in addition to, your rights at law (including under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993). IMPORTANT: Please keep this warranty and complete the details below for your own records. Keep this with your original purchase documents for any claim under warranty. Lifetime Extension Warranty - Domestic/Residential

This warranty is given on the understanding that the product is installed and operated according to the installation guide provided and the Australian/New Zealand standard AS/NZS3500, by a registered plumber.

Subject to any other rights or remedies that you may have under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 (or any other applicable legislation). Felton Industries Limited agrees to either repair or replace (at Felton's sole discretion) the Mixer (as defined below) if it is discovered that the Mixer contains a material defect which arose in the course of its manufacture, on and subject to the Terms and Conditions set out below.

What Lifetime Extension Warranty does cover:

- 1) This warranty extension applies in respect of Felton sink, basin and shower mixing valves ("Mixer") which are used in residential/domestic installations only.
- 2) This warranty is for the lifetime of the first registered owner of the residential dwelling in which the Mixer is installed and who completes this warranty card and is not transferable to any subsequent owner of the dwelling (subject to paragraph 5 under 'What Lifetime Extension Warranty does not cover).
- 3) This warranty extension covers the repair or replacement only of Mixer parts for a lifetime period provided that you register the purchase and installation of the Mixer with Felton by returning this warranty card to us within 6 months from the date of purchase.
 4) This warranty extension covers labour relating solely to repairing or replacing the Mixer for a period of 5 years from the date of purchase, provided the product is installed by a registered plumber in accordance with Felton's installation instructions and the Australian/New Zealand standard AS/NZS3500 and you return this warranty card to us

What Lifetime Extension Warranty does not cover:

- 1) This warranty extension does not apply to shower hoses, Designer wall sets, and shower heads nor does it apply to the Feltonmix range of products.
- 2) This warranty will be null and void unless the Mixer is installed by a registered plumber in accordance with Felton's installation instructions. A registered plumber is a person registered as a registered plumber with the NZ Plumber Gasfitters and Drainlayers Boar
- 3) This warranty is for manufacturing defects only and the Mixer must not have been damaged by misuse, accident or neglect. Fair wear and tear is expressly excluded.
- 4) This warranty is provided to persons who are a "consumer" under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 and for use in domestic/ residential dwellings in New Zealand only, not for commercial use. It is not transferable and shall apply to the first registered owner of the Mixer only.
- 5) Notwithstanding point 4. above, where the Mixer has been purchased and installed in a residential dwelling by a party that has constructed that dwelling with the intention of sale, this warranty will apply to the first occupier of that home (but shall not apply to any subsequent occupiers of that home).
- 6) Where Felton elects, in its sole discretion, to provide you with a replacement Mixer the cost of freight will be met by you.
- 7) In order for the Lifetime Extension Warranty to apply, you must complete the registration form and return this warranty card to Felton within 6 months from the date of purchase of the Mixer.
- 8) All repair work covered by this warranty must be performed by an authorised Felton Service Partner, Felton staff member or, provided that approval is first obtained from Felton and an authorisation number is provided to you by Felton, a certified plumber. The Mixer must not have been tampered with or repaired in any other way other than in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
- 9) Product purchased before 1st of April 2014 is not covered by this warranty.
