From the outset, Felton has epitomised classic Kiwi ingenuity. Combining innovative design and manufacturing to suit our NZ conditions.



## Looking Back: 50 Years of Tapware and Innovation

The entrepreneur's dream is to meet a market need in a new, compelling and enduring way.

Felton's founder Max Davies was already past retirement age when he founded the company. Despite not being formally trained, and having left school at 14, Max had previoulsy owned a successful electrical element manufacturer, Hermetic Ltd.

Through Hermetic Ltd (now Zip Plumbing), he met Keith Relf from Victor Industries and they agreed to further develop and manufacture Keith's concept for a new type of shower mixer. The rest, as they say, is history!

Max Davies passed away in June 1995 at 93 years old, having worked at Felton right up until age 91. Few of the people whose lives his work improved know of him and his legacy. And yet his impact was — and is — substantial. We are humbled and proud at Felton to build on Max's founding legacy in working with you.

Felton formally registered on 23rd September by Max Davies at Felton Matthew Avenue - the street address being the basis of the company's name.



### 1969

Launched Feltonmix™ technology - the first shower mixer to work on unequal water pressure.



### 1979

Manufactured first isolator valve made completely from engineering plastics.



### 198

Apricot colour added to the Caroma colour range of Ivory, Avocado, Red, Royal Blue and Chocolate.



### 1987

Introduced the first plastic bodied shower mixer using engineering plastics and sealing system.



The first Felton slide rail manufactured in NZ.



### 991

Passed the Australian MP52 and given permission to use Watermark.



### 2001

Venturi exposed outlet shower mixer enigeered, launched and manufactured in New Zealand.

### 2002

Felton's irst stainless steel slide rail with patented mounting system manufactured in New Zealand.

### 2003

Felton became the first NZ Company to exhibit at ISH Frankfurt (Germany), the industries' biggest international trade fair.



### 2004

Venturi concealed outlet shower mixer launched.



### 2005

Moved to bigger premises on Farmhouse Lane Glen Innes, after almost 40 years at Felton Matthew Ave.




## Designer III: A classic story of Kiwi innovation

Having sold more than 1.7 million mixers in the 50 years since it was developed, the Feltonmix has earned the trust of New Zealand plumbers and homeowners, and it continues to prove its reliability and performance time and time again.



1979

Manufactured first isolator valve made completely from engineering plastics.











1985

Wallset designed by Gifford Jackson. Caroma Apricot colour added to range on offer.

1986

Introduced the first plastic bodied shower mixer using engineering plastics and sealing system.

1987

Ironically the Feltonmix '86' mixer wasn't launched until February 1987.



1998

The Designer wallset was

launched. A variety of colours

were available - Chrome, White,

Ivory, Mist Grey, Apricot

and Gold.









2000

The Designer II was released.



2016

Designer III launched with a few product improvements: a wider faceplate and shower head to give full coverage.


## Celebrating 50 years with the release of Max

## **Ease leaking shower worries**

Water leaking into walls can cause a number of problems, not least of which - mould growth is a serious health issue. With such an accessible solution, is it really worth the risk?





Damage caused by leaking shower installations can be devastating to homeowners - not just from a structural and financial point of view but health-wise as well.

Aquatite is an innovative NZ company which offers customers the Wetwall Caddy™, a molded ABS plastic device that encloses water control valves and plumbing connections, and protects the wall cavity from any potential leaks that may occur.

Aquatite's focus is to provide a product to property developers, architects and those in the trade industry so they can ensure the highest standard of protection in both existing and new homes. The Wetwall  $\mathsf{Caddy}^{\scriptscriptstyle{\mathsf{M}}}$  was developed as a solution to the ongoing problem of leaking showers and is proud to be sustainable as well as compliant to both NZ Building Code E3 internal moisture and AS374. And it ensures that access holes are sealed.


The Waterproofing Membrane Association (NZ) Inc. have a Code of Practice which gives clear instruction on dealing with membrane penetrations. Shower mixers /outlets require either a proprietary "Wet Wall Caddy" fitted to manufacturer's instructions or the waterproofing membrane sealed up to the penetration.

The purpose of this Code of Practice is to apply best industry practice to ensure that the requirements of NZBC Clause E3 Internal Moisture, and accompanying Acceptable Solution E3/AS1 are met and sometimes exceeded. This Code of Practice is also applicable to buildings outside of E3, such as commercial food preparation areas.

All wet areas containing a water supply must:

- Be protected with a wet area membrane
- Be contained by a waterstop
- · Have all penetrations sealed

The over-arching principle must always be to design for any potential situation where there could be water spillage and that the membrane should be carried behind wall mounted fittings from the floor up the wall to at least the point of entry through the wall of the plumbing fitting.





As well as preventing water damage, the Wetwall Caddy™ adds real value by empowering homeowners with information if they have a water leak on their hands.

Smartflow & Smartview are digital thermostatic shower mixers featuring Swiss technology which allows you to alter your water temperature & flow comfortably at the touch of a button.


There are three programmable memory settings to customise your shower temperature & flow rate as well as the ability to set a maximum temperature. The thermostatic mixers allow constant water temperatures even when other taps in the house are used, making for a safer shower, especially for children & the elderly.

Felton Digital Smartflow and Smartview come with a 5 year warranty and are available through specialist plumbing and bathroom distributors.


